You'll learn how to achieve a great fit using "tissue fitting" and professional sewing construction techniques. During the workshop you will construct a pair of Classic Pants from woven fabric or Magic Pants from stretch woven fabric that will fit beautifully!



**The Perfect T-Shirt ~or~ The Swing Tunic**

**For this workshop, you will have a choice!**

You probably think of a t-shirt as that comfy top you throw on to do the house-work. In reality, a nice fitting t-shirt can be the most versatile top in your wardrobe. This selection from Pamela's Patterns addresses all the fitting issues women face (rounded shoulders and back, full bust, hip room, etc.), and gives you a t-shirt you'll be proud to wear anywhere! Make it casual, dressy, or anything in between. You'll use this pattern over and over again!

This adaptation of the popular cold shoulder style, The Peek-A-Boo Swing Tunic, is thoughtfully designed with the modest woman in mind. Pamela makes it sew very appropriate by creating a scaled down version that shows just a "peek" of shoulder and covers any bra strap. If this isn't your style, choose the classic shoulder option - the choice is yours! The swing-y tunic shape shows off an "essence-of-waist" and hides a lot of fluff. There are multiple sleeve length options including a flattering elbow length and a bohemian style "fit & flare". Choose a modified or lower scoop neckline, or the stunning asymmetric style. Very chic!

"I have had the unique opportunity to work with hundreds of women over the years to help them achieve a good fit from commercial patterns. While doing this, I found that many of the pattern adjustments we were doing were consistent for the majority of women. As a result, my patterns have been designed to reflect these common changes, resulting in less changes to the pattern and garment during the construction process. Commercial patterns go through a computer drafting program that doesn't allow for these common changes to be made. Pamela's Patterns are hand drafted with many prototypes before they go into production. I hope you enjoy these patterns as much as I enjoyed making them!"

Pamela Leggett has been teaching sewing since 1981. While specializing in pattern fitting, fine garment sewing skills, knits and serging, she has developed a fun and informative teaching style that is a delight to be around as well as available in her patterns and instructional DVD's.
