

Lidya Phone Wallet Supplies

Materials:

- 3 co-ordinated FQ of fabric (A and B for Exterior, C for Lining)
- ¼ yd of Medium weight fusible interfacing: Pellon SF101 Shape-Flex / Vilene G700
- ¼ yd of fusible fleece: Pellon 987F / Vilene H640 or Decovil for a firmer touch
- Clear Vinyl for interior pockets - I suggest the thin thickness, because the phone loses touch sensitivity if the vinyl is thick. – I used 18 mil on mine

Hardware/Tools:

- Setting Tools
- One Kam snap (14mm) or other closing of your choice (I will have Kam snaps in class)
- Co-ordinating thread, rotary cutter or scissors and general sewing supplies
- Dry erase marker
- Teflon foot * recommended, but can be done without
- Ruler
- Fabric Glue or Double Sided Tape (optional)
- clips or pins

Notes:

- If you use vinyl or cork, cut the fleece 3/8 "shorter in both width and height than their respective fabrics; this reduces the bulk of the seams. Use clips instead of pins and use a longer stitch length too.
- If you're interested in adding a slip pocket or 2 see the notes on page 13.

1- Use your pattern piece (D) and cut on fold 1 Exterior fabric.

2- Cut 1 woven fusible interfacing with the following measure: 8 1/8"H x 7 3/8"W

MEASUREMENTS: Finished size: 7 3/8"W x 4 3/8"H

Please have your pattern pieces cut out before class.
