

Bionic Gear Bag Supply List

Prior to Class - you will need to purchase the Bionic Gear Bag Notions Tote Pattern (Not the Sew Together Bag) from www.craftsy.com

The pattern is 35 pages, included are lots of pictures and helpful tips, either you can print the pattern for class or bring you laptop to follow along.

It is recommended that you read thru the pattern instructions prior to class.

Please have your fabric/interfacing/batting PRIOR to class.

There are many cutting/fabric options for this pattern, attached is cutting instructions for one example using 3 coordinating fabrics.

Materials List

- 1 1/4 yard Fabric (44" wide) if doing all in one color. If using multiple colors (max 3), the yardage will vary, see attached cutting sample. I suggest you use quilting weight cotton - at least for your first one.
- I do NOT recommend using directional fabric for your first Bionic Gear Bag.
- 10" by 17" piece Exterior Batting - (I like Pellon 987F)
- 1 1/2 yard Interfacing for linings (I like Pellon 91)
- 1 - 24" Polyester / Nylon Zipper for Exterior
- 4 - 12" Polyester / Nylon Zipper for pockets • Thread
- Sewing Machine Needles - I have good luck with Microtex size 80/12 & 90/14's
- Thread for construction and matching or coordinating thread for topstitching
- Sewing Machine in good working order
- Usual sewing supplies, including seam ripper, scissors, pins, marking pencil
- WONDER CLIPS work great for this project!
- Hand sewing needle if you choose to hand stitch the binding

Bionic Gear Bag — sample cutting instructions

There are many fabric cutting options for this pattern, you can use 1 or more different fabrics, the following is an example of cutting instructions using 3 coordinating fabrics:

Cut and LABEL each piece with the corresponding letter

Leftover fabric? It is a good idea to bring leftover fabric/interfacing/batting to class "just in case"!

Fabric #1 - Exterior -	Cut 1 -	10" x 16 1/2"
Sides, both exterior & interior -	Cut 4 -	Pattern Piece "I" included in Pattern*
(*Important, see pattern piece "I" for instructions regarding the accuracy check)		
Lining between zip pocket 1 & 2-	Cut 1 -	10" x 7 1/2"
Lining between zip pocket 2 & 3-	Cut 1 -	10" x 9 3/4"
Lining between zip pocket 3 & 4-	Cut 1 -	10" x 10 1/2"

Fabric #2 - Front Interior Flap Lining	Cut 1 -	10" x 10 1/2"
Rear Lining Zip 4 to Binding 5	Cut 1 -	10" x 10 1/2"

Fabric #3 - Zip Pocket 1, inside lining	Cut 2 -	10" x 3 1/2"
"H" Zip Pocket 2,3,4, inside lining	Cut 6 -	10" x 4 1/2"
Exterior Side Bindings	Cut 2 -	2 1/4" x 18"
Zip 5, exterior top bindings	Cut 2 -	2 1/4" x 24"
Zipper Tabs	Cut 2 -	1 3/4" x 3"

Interfacing - Cut 3 - 9 3/4" x 9 3/4"
Cut 1 - 9 3/4" x 7 1/4"
Cut 2 - Using Pattern Piece and trim edges about 1/8" of an inch

Batting - Cut 1 - 10" x 16 1/2"
